### **Lectio Prayer**

Using the word of God, one is led by the Spirit to the highest levels of communion with God; enshrined in Benedictine spirituality; expressed in the classic wording of Guigo II, a twelfth-century Carthusian abbot in his *Ladder of Monks*, “Seek in reading and you will find in meditating; knock in mental prayer and it will be opened to you by contemplation.”

1. Reading (an exercise of the outward senses) provides the subject matter for meditation.
2. Meditation (thinking) is concerned with understanding; it digs for treasure which it finds and reveals, but which is beyond its power to seize.
3. Prayer (responding) is concerned with desire; this prayer lifts itself up to God with all strength and begs for the treasure it longs for.
4. Contemplation (resting outstrips every faculty; (when it comes) it rewards the labors of the three, “inebriating the thirsting soul with the dew of heavenly sweetness.”

### **The Seven Women Prophets**

Sarah, Miriam, Deborah, Hannah, Abigail, Hulda, and Esther. These are traditionally recognized in the Old Testament. Anna is the only New testament prophetess named (Luke 2:36- 38)

### **The Three Stages in the Formation of the Gospels**

1. **The life and teaching of Jesus**—Jesus’ actual words and deeds
2. **The oral Tradition**—After the ascension, the apostles with fuller understanding
3. **The written Gospels**—The sacred authors took certain of the many elements which had been handed on, at times explaining or synthesizing in light of the situation of the churches

### **Rites (liturgical traditions) of the catholic Church**

Rites evolved throughout Church history, based on the culture of a particular time, place, and people. Since all these Rites are Catholic (in union with Rome) Catholics may fulfill worship obligations in any Rite, with no restrictions. The distinction *Eastern or Western* depends on the Rite’s area of origin within the Roman Empire. The Latin Rite is most common in the Western Church (hence the popularized “Roman catholic, “Latin Being Roman).

### **The Unity in the Catholicity of the Church**

1. Open profession of faith
2. One celebration of the seven sacraments (“mysteries”)
3. One hierarchical unity
