The *limbus* (Latin: edge, fringe) of heaven. A scriptural notion, though the word is not in the Bible; a theological attempt to reconcile the necessity of Baptism (John 3:5) with God's eternal mercy.

Obligations

Formerly, fast days consisted of all Lenten days except Sunday. Fast and abstinence days were Ash Wednesday, Lenten Fridays, and Saturdays, Ember Days, the vigils of certain feasts. Current practice reflects the 1966 instructions of Pope Paul VI's constitution *Paenitemini* in which:

1. The meaning of fasting was emphasized.
2. The obligation was restated.
3. The extent of the obligation was changed.
4. The universal fast and abstinence days, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, were confirmed.
5. Some other act of penance should be followed on Fridays if abstinence from meat is not practiced.
6. Specific regulations were left to bishops in their Episcopal conferences.

Angels

Definition

Heavenly beings, genderless, of a fixed population, who neither marry nor are given in marriage (mark 12:25); distinct from saint (which humans may become); mentioned nearly 300 times in the Bible.

The Three Triads of Celestial Hierarchy

1. Counselors (angels of the Presence) – seraphim (Isaiah 6:2), cherubim (Exodus 10), thrones
2. Governors (angels over forces of nature)—dominations, virtues, powers
3. Messengers (angels ministering directly to human) – principalities, archangels, angels
