Sins that Cry to Heaven for Vengeance

These are from the Catechetical tradition.

1. The blood of Abel (Genesis 4:10) or willful murder
2. The sin of the Sodomites (Genesis 18:20, 19:13) or sins against nature
3. The cry of the people oppressed in Egypt (Exodus 3:7-10) or oppression of those who are poor
4. The cry of the alien, the widow, and the orphan (Exodus 20:20-22) or oppression of aliens, widows, and orphans
5. Injustice to the wage earner (Deuteronomy 24:14-15, James 5:4) or defrauding laborers of their just wages

The Meaning of Death

1. Death is the end of earthly life.
2. Death is a consequence of sin.
3. Death is transformed by Christ.

Oral Prophets

The oral prophets are distinct from the literary prophets whose books are contained in the prophetic books of the Bible. There are five major oral prophets.

1. Samuel (enthroned David)
2. Nathan (advisor to David)
3. Ahijah (advisor to Jeroboam)
4. Elijah (led resistance against Baal cult)
5. Elisha (led resistance against Baal cult)

The Six Sins against the Holy Spirit

The *Catechism of the Church* cites Mark 3:29, “Whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin” (See also Matthew 12:32, Luke 12:10), and then explains that God’s mercy has no limits, but that a person who refuses to accept his mercy by repenting rejects forgiveness and the salvation offered by the Holy Spirit. This hardness of heart can lead to a refusal to repent at the time of death and to eternal loss.

1. Despair of one’s salvation (of God’s mercy)
2. Presumption of saving oneself without merit
3. Resisting the known truth
4. Envy of the graces received by others
5. Obstinacy in one’s sins
6. Final impenitence

The Two Senses of Scripture

There is a medieval verse, “The letter speaks of belief; allegory to faith; the moral how to act; anagogy our destiny.”

1. The literal sense—the meaning, interpreted rightly, on which all other senses are based
2. The spiritual sense—the deeper significance of the text
 - The allegorical sense—event’s significance recognized in Christ
 - The moral sense—event’s role in leading us to act justly
 - The anagogical sense—event’s eternal significance
