The Jesus Prayer

This ancient Eastern Christian contemplative prayer invokes the name of Jesus, the only name in the world given us by which we are to be saved (Acts 4:12; also 2:21; 9:14, 21, for example). Developed by the Desert Fathers, it consists of short phrases from the Scriptures which are repeated interiorly with attention to Christ's presence until prayer becomes one with breathing and the Lord makes a house within (John 14:23, Revelation 3:20)

The most popular phrase combines the Christological hymn of Philippians 2:6-11 with the cry of the tax collector (Luke 18:13) and of the blind man begging (Luke 18:38-39): "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner."

God has given Jesus a name to be exalted (Philippians 2:9-11) with a saving power that is sign and source of the Spirit within (1 Corinthians 12:3). The Jesus Prayer especially invites a person to assume a conscious prayer position, to become centered mentally, and to breathe rhythmically (in with the first phrase, out with the second, and so on).

This Dedication of the day to the Sacred Heart originated with members of the Apostleship of Prayer (League of the Sacred Heart).

Franciscan Crown or Seraphic Rosary

This rosary of seven decades was introduced among the Franciscans in 1422. Two Hail Marys were added since then, to total seventy –two, the traditional age of Mary at her assumption. This rosary commemorates the seven joys of the Blessed Mother:

1. Annunciation
2. Visitation
3. Nativity
4. Adoration
5. Finding the Temple
6. Appearances of the Risen Christ to His Mother
7. Assumption and Coronation
