The Mains Sins of Irreligion

1. Tempting God—putting God’s goodness to the test
2. Sacrilege (Latin: sacrilegium)—stealing sacred things; refers to profaning sacraments, liturgical action, persons, things, or places consecrated to God; normally refers to an action—desecration—but also to sacrilegious talk
3. Simony—buying or selling spiritual things (See Acts 8:20.)
4. Atheism (including practical materialism, atheistic humanism)—considering humans as ends in themselves, and theories of economic and social liberation apart from God
5. Agnosticism—a “practical atheism,” ideas or indifference that often refrains from formally denying God

The Catholic Church is Apostolic

1. Because the apostles founded it
2. Because the apostles’ teaching is handed on by it
3. Because the apostles’ successors, the bishops, lead it

Oratory

Place of prayer other than a parish church, designated by ecclesiastical authority for Mass devotions; public, semipublic, or private (which is a private family chapel)

Sacrificial Giving (Part 1)

A voluntary, proportionate, systematic, sacrificial, and liturgical giving of money that is part of the larger self-giving of time, talent, and treasure. (“Church Support” is not the same as sacrificial giving, but is a by-product of it.)

1. Voluntary—neither an assessment nor a tax (which the “tithe” became).
2. Proportionate—like the widow Jesus praised, though she gave little (Luke 21:2).
 - The Old Testament “tithe” was literally ten percent (of gross income) : that may be too much for some, too little for others.
 - It includes paychecks, dividends, social security payments, allowances, windfalls, and so on.
3. Systematic (planned)
 - Part of the budget
 - As income is received (not” when somebody needs it”)
4. Sacrificial
 - “Making holy” (the literal meaning of “sacrifice”) the earnings and efforts of the week
 - If it doesn’t hurt (require a sacrifice), it’s only a donation, or a contribution, not Sacrificial giving, which is a measure of one’s trust in God

Benediction

Generally, a blessing; specifically, the common term for Eucharistic devotion.

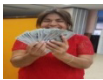
Upcoming Events:

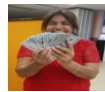

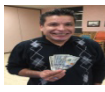
