Lectionary

The “collection of readings” (Scripture), assigned by the Church for liturgical proclamation. The present one was introduced March 22, 1970, and revised in 1998. It consists of:

1. A three- year cycle of Sunday readings
2. A two-year weekday cycle
3. A one- year sanctoral cycle
4. A variety of other readings for various occasions
5. Responsorial psalms and alleluia verses

5. Ecumenical formation of the faithful, especially of priest

Why Seven?

A solar year, a lunar month, and a twenty-four- hour day are naturals, but a seven-day week is supernatural. Seven is holy. Seven is magic. Seven days make a week. This was determined even by the author of Genesis—or God himself—who, in seven days or one “week,” according to the story, created the world, and rested from it. So this seven-day cycle from the beginning was religious. The Romans’ week was also seven days, named after the heavenly bodies of the sun, the moon, and the planets (five of which the Romans knew). Seven... one week’s worth of days.

Obligations

Formerly, fast days consisted of all Lenten days except Sunday. Fast and abstinence days were Ash Wednesday, Lenten Fridays, and Saturdays, Ember Days, and the vigils of certain feasts. Current practice reflects the 1966 instructions of Pope Paul VI’s constitution *Paenitemini* in which:

1. The meaning of fasting was emphasized.
2. The obligation was restated.
3. The extent of the obligation was changed.
4. The universal fast and abstinence days, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, were confirmed.
5. Some other act of penance should be followed on Fridays if abstinence from meat is not practiced.
6. Specific regulations were left to bishops in their Episcopal conferences.
