The Three Valid Methods of Baptism

1. Aspersion (sprinkling): Used only in exceptional circumstances.
2. Infusion (pouring): A practice already in the first century, according to *The Didache*. Paul was baptized in a private house (Acts 9:17-18), and Peter baptized his jailer's family presumably still in prison area (Acts 16:33). Many have concluded that these baptisms and others were done either by sprinkling or pouring, since no river or stream is mentioned, and since pool/tubs were rare among those who were poor.
3. Immersion (dipping or plunging): Generally used in the early Church, common in the Eastern Church and certain Protestant traditions; since Vatican II, permissible in the Latin Rite.

Rood screen

An ornamented altar screen usually surmounted with a crucifix, separating the sanctuary from the body of the church. Properly, "rood" (rod) is the crucifixion cross (crucifix) which was originally enshrined on the stone or wooden screen. This came to be ornamented with saintly statuary and symbols

ARCHANGELS: MICHAEL, GABRIEL, AND RAPHAEL

Three of the special messengers mentioned in the Bible are the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. The names of each of these archangels tell us about the work God gave them to do.

- Michael's name ("who is like God") God gave the responsibility of protecting us as God protects us.
- Gabriel's name ("hero of God") God's hero because he communicates God's message to people. We remember Gabriel best for being the angel who announced to Mary that she would be the mother of God's only son.
- Raphael's name ("God has healed") in the bible Raphael heals a blind man and is said to have stirred the water in a pool where Jesus healed a paralyzed man.

We remember that God's messengers guide us in our journey to everlasting life with our Father. We can pray to Michael when we face temptation. We can ask Gabriel to help us say "yes" to God as Mary did so many years ago. We can pray to Raphael when we are ill or know someone is in need of healing.
