General Principles of the New Lectionary

- Gospel: During Ordinary Time readings are organic, which is the term for a continuous or semi-continuous reading of a text. A particular book or letter is treated as a whole and not “as related to something else.”
- First Reading (Sundays): Old Testament readings are chosen thematically. The choices according to themes show clearly the unity and relationship between the Old and New Testament.
- Second Reading: The choices are organic, providing a semi-continuous reading of Paul and James. (Peter & John are read during Easter and Christmas season).
- First Reading (Weekdays): Like the second reading on Sunday, the first reading of weekday liturgies is organic, although more selective than on Sundays, since both Testaments are used.

St. Luke, Evangelists

Luke (Martyr) is called the winged ox, since he deals with the sacrificial aspects of Christ’s life and since his version of the Gospel begins with a temple scene.

Rite of Reception of Baptized Christians into Full Communion

Reception takes place, ideally, within Mass, after the Homily

- Profession of faith by the assembly and the one being received.
- Declaration of reception by the Bishop (or Priest taking his place).
- Sacrament of Confirmation
- General intercessions
- Sign of Peace
- Liturgy of the Eucharist, in which the person receives Communion for the first time.

4. Accurate and caring knowledge of each other
5. Ecumenical formation of the faithful, especially the priests
