All Saints' Day

All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church celebrated annually on November 1. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. It should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on November 2, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven. Generally, All Saints' Day is a Catholic Holy Day of Obligation, meaning all Catholics are required to attend Mass on that day, unless they have an excellent excuse, such as serious illness.

All Souls' Day

According to Catholic belief, the soul of a person who dies can go to one of three places. The first is heaven, where a person who dies in a state of perfect grace and communion with God goes. The second is hell, where those who die in a state of mortal sin are naturally condemned by their choice. The intermediate option is purgatory, which is thought to be where most people, free of mortal sin, but still in a state of lesser (venial) sin, must go. Purgatory is necessary so that souls can be cleansed and perfected before they enter into heaven. There is scriptural basis for this belief. The primary reference is in 2 Maccabees, 12:26 and 12:32. "Turning to supplication, they prayed that the sinful deed might be fully blotted out... Thus made atonement for the dead that they might be free from sin."

Halloween?

"Hallows' Eve" sounds like "Halloween," and it should, because that's where it came from: the eve, or vigil, of All Hallows, which is All Saints'. On All Souls' Day (which is the day after All Saints' Day) the poor begged for food and promised to pray for the dead in return. They called the little cakes they received "soul cakes"- not the biggest stretch from today's trick-or-treat spoils. Masks and costumes? Maybe these disguises will confuse the evil spirits. Candy has displaced the true soul cake, the doughnut (the cake with the hole in the center making a circle, representing eternity). There are still cultures with people who visit a cemetery on All Hallows, not for the spooky reasons.
