All Saints' Day

All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church celebrated annually on November 1. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. It should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on November 2, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven. Generally, All Saints' Day is a Catholic Holy Day of Obligation, meaning all Catholics are required to attend Mass on that day, unless they have an excellent excuse, such as serious illness.

All Souls' Day

According to Catholic belief, the soul of a person who dies can go to one of three places. The first is heaven, where a person who dies in a state of perfect grace and communion with God goes. The second is hell, where those who die in a state of mortal sin are naturally condemned by their choice. The intermediate option is purgatory, which is thought to be where most people, free of mortal sin, but still in a state of lesser (venial) sin, must go. Purgatory is necessary so that souls can be cleansed and perfected before they enter into heaven. There is scriptural basis for this belief. The primary reference is in 2 Maccabees, 12:26 and 12:32. "Turning to supplication, they prayed that the sinful deed might be fully blotted out... Thus made atonement for the dead that they might be free from sin."

Purgatory

Purgatory is the suffering of the faithful which causes a "purging" of temporal punishment due to sin. It is explained in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (#1054) as a process (not a place) a purification after death for those who are saved, so that they may achieve the holiness necessary to enter heaven. It is implied in Scripture (Revelation 6th 9-11; 1 Peter 3:18-19), taught by the early fathers, and defined by the Church (especially the Council of Florence, 1439). Pope Paul VI (in his apostolic constitution *Indulgentiarum Doctrina*, 5) remind us, "A perennial link of charity exist between the faithful who have already reached their heavenly home, those who are expiating their sins in purgatory, and those who are still pilgrims on earth. Between them there is, too, an abundant exchange of all good things."
