#### **Cathedral**

The church of the diocesan Church, bishop's "chair". It is traditionally located in the see city from which the diocese takes its name. The pastor of the cathedral is the ordinary (bishop or archbishop); hence, the priest who actually conducts the cathedral parish and its affairs has the title rector, not pastor or parish priest.

#### **Chapel**

Place of liturgical worship for a community other than a parish (school, hospital, convent, seminary and so forth); a room within a building, or a separate building. The word chapel, interestingly, comes from the famous story of St. Martin and the cloak he gave to a beggar. Cloak in Latin is cappa, and cappella is the diminutive. In Old French the same word is chapel, and that was the name given to the oratory in which the alleged chapel of St. Martin was preserved.

#### **Relics:**

Relics are objects associated with saints:

- First Class designates an actual body or part of a body (for example, the tongue of St. Anthony, preserved at his shrine in Padua).
- Second Class is an article of clothing or some other article used by a saint.
- Third Class is any object touched to a first class relic.
