**Hail Mary (Latin Ave Mary)**

The Hail Mary is a composite of the angel Gabriel's greeting (Luke 1:28) and Elizabeth's greeting (Luke 1:42), both to Mary. It has been a popular prayer since the eleventh century. The name Jesus was added in the thirteenth century. Various versions of the Holy Mary emerged in the fourteenth century and were in general use by the sixteenth century.

**Traditional Prayer (Act of Faith)**

O my God, I firmly believe that you are one God in three divine Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; I believe that your divine Son became man and died for our sins, and that he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe these and all the truths which the Holy Catholic Church teaches, because you revealed them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived.

**Holy, Holy, Holy Lord**

These texts are based on two Scripture references: Isaiah 6:3 and Mark 11:9-10 (Jesus' entry into Jerusalem). The prayer was probably first used in the East, but it was quickly incorporated into the Eucharist in the West. It is prayed at the Beginning of the Eucharistic Prayer.

**The Rosary**

The Rosary is called the Psalter of Mary because all fifteen of its mysteries, with their 150 Aves, correspond to the number of the psalms. Praying all fifteen decades at once is called the Dominican Rosary. The Rosary is the most well known and used form of chaplet (a devotion using beads; from a French word meaning "crown" or "wreath"). There are other chaplets, such as those in honor of St. Bridget of Sweden and in honor of Mary, the Immaculate Conception.

**Apostles' Creed**

The Apostles' Creed is the epitome of Christian doctrine. In twelve articles, it contains the truth taught by the apostles. It has existed essentially since the second century and was first referred to in the fourth century. The earliest text dates from the eighth century. Developed by early centuries of the Western Church, catechumens were required to learn and recite it before Baptism.

**Litanies**

Since Vatican II (1962-1965), these are the formally indulgenced litanies: Holy Name, Precious Blood, St. Joseph, Sacred Heart, Blessed Virgin, and All Saints. Other litanies not indulgenced but approved for the faithful number over a hundred. Each begins with an invocation of the Trinity.

**Mary's Cantic**

Mary's Cantic is Mary's response to Elizabeth's greeting at the visitation. The canticles title in Latin, Magnificat, comes from the opening words: "My soul magnifies..." or "proclaims." The Magnificat is prayed each day by the Church as part of its Evening Prayer.

**Confiteor**

Mea Culpa: through my fault" (or "it's my fault"), is a phase in any Confiteor, particularly the one sometimes used during the penitential rite of the Mass.
