### **Suscipe** (“receive,” “accept”)

Also called “A Prayer of Self-Offering,” it may be compared to the *Suscipiat* of Mass, “May the Lord receive this sacrifice...” It is the prayer from the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius Loyola.

### **God’s Omnipotence**

This is the first divine attributed named in the Creed.

1. God’s power is universal
2. God’s power is loving.
3. God’s power is mysterious (discerned only by faith)

### **The Divine Praises**

The Divine Praises were traditionally recited after the Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. They were composed possibly about 1800 in reparation for profanity and blasphemy. Invocations 5, 6 10, 11 and 13 are post mid-nineteenth century additions.

### **Sacramentals**

Sacred signs that “extend and radiate the sacraments,” signifying the mostly spiritual effects obtained through the Church’s intercession and disposing a person to the grace of the sacraments.

### **Baptism Candles**

Their lighting (from the Christ candle) and presentation are part of Christian initiation, with the exhortation to keep the flame of faith burning brightly. One custom is to light one’s baptismal candle each year on the anniversary of one’s baptism

### **Franciscans Crown or Seraphic Rosary**

This Rosary of seven decades was introduced among the Franciscans in 1422. Two hail Marys were added since then, to total seventy-two, the traditional age of Mary at her assumption. The rosary commemorates the seven joys of the Blessed Mother

1. Annunciation
2. Visitation
3. Nativity
4. Adoration of the Magi
5. Finding the temple
6. Appearance of the Risen Christ to His Mother
7. Assumption and Coronation
