Advent

Advent is the season of expectation of the Christ, and it is somewhat penitential in tone. It is four weeks long, or slightly less, the first two focusing on Jesus' final coming as Lord and judge. The final eight days anticipate his coming in history (Christ-mas). Since the tenth century, the first Sunday in Advent has marked the beginning of the Church year in the West. (The Third Sunday of Advent, traditionally named Gaudete Sunday, expresses a joyful note of anticipation in the season).

Sundays

Sunday is the day the Church celebrates the Paschal mystery, the "Lord's Day", according to the apostolic tradition that the day of Jesus' resurrection from the dead was the first day of the week (Sunday). The Sundays of Advent, Lent, and the Easter Season take precedence over the permanent assignment of another celebration.
