Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time is the name given to the thirty-three or thirty-four weeks (depending upon Easter) in the course of the year apart from Advent/Christmas and Lent/Triduum/Easter. Ordinary Time is that part of the liturgical year when no particular moment or aspect of the Christian mystery is celebrated.

The Church as a House of Prayer

The word Church comes originally from Greek kuriakos (of the Lord). The Catechism of the Catholic teaches (#1180), "These visible churches are not simply gathering places but signify and make visible the Church living in this pace, the dwelling of God with men reconciled and united in Christ". It goes on to quote paragraph 5 of Vatican II's "Decree on the Ministry and Life of Priests":

1. A church is a house of prayer
2. Where the Eucharist is celebrated and reserved
3. Where the faithful assemble, and
4. Where the presence of the Son of God our savior is worshiped.
