Getting Ready For Lent

Historically, Lent was the retreat-like final preparation period for catechumens, those being initiated into the Church and into the Paschal mystery at the Easter Vigil. Naturally enough, it became in time a renewal period for the already baptized faithful, the sponsoring community being inspired by the conversion of the catechumens. It was also a time of penance for those enrolled in the order of penitents, an early form of the Sacrament of Penance, limited to serious sinners.

Fast and Abstinence

Fasting refers to limitations on food and drink. Until 1966, in the modern Church, the regulations for days of fast prescribed taking only one full daily meal, plus breakfast and a “collation” (light meal). Abstaining, in this context, means refraining from certain kinds of food or drink, typically meat. From the first century, the day of the crucifixion has been traditionally observed as a day of abstaining from flesh meat to honor Christ who sacrificed his flesh on a Friday.

Lent

The annual Lenten season is the fitting time to climb the holy mountain of Easter. The Lenten season has a double character, namely to prepare both catechumens and faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery. The catechumens, both with the rite of election and scrutinizes, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian initiation; the faithful, ever more attentive to the word of the God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises.

Fasting

Fasting before Communion has been a practice from ancient times. It was prescribed by the Council of Carthage (254) and Antioch (268) and became universal practice by the fifth century. Prior to 1953 the faithful fasted from midnight on, including from water and medicine. In 1953 and again in 1957, Pope Pius XII reduced the time to three hours from solid food and alcoholic drink.
