**Reflexión**

Cuando los bebés son bautizados, los padres, con la ayuda de los padrinos, asumen la responsabilidad de criar al niño como seguidor de Jesús. El proceso de maduración en la fe es muy parecido al ejemplo que se encuentra en la historia del hombre nacido ciego. El hombre está curado de su ceguera, un símbolo de su pecado. Cada vez que conoce a alguien después de la curación, el hombre se da cuenta de quién es Jesús. De manera similar, los que somos bautizados continuamos madurando en la fe a medida que crece nuestra relación y conocimiento sobre Jesús.

**Reflection**

As in last week’s Gospel about Jesus’ encounter with the Samaritan woman, today’s reading has many allusions to Baptism. The washing of the man in the pool of Siloam is a prototype for Christian Baptism. Through the man’s encounter with Jesus, the man born blind is healed, his sight is restored, and his conversion to discipleship begins. The man born blind gradually comes to a greater understanding about who Jesus is and what it means to be his disciple, while the Pharisees (those who should see) are the ones who remain blind.
