Reflection:

What God have Simeon and Anna perceived in the child's eyes? How disconcerting is the tenderness of God made fragile babbling, inviting Simeon to abandon himself, in turn, in the arms of God, cradled, cradled by the God Whom Now he cradles? What joy, barely glimpsed in the closeness of God, undoing so much paralyzing fear that it destroys the true experience of God's love! Praying is thus not clinging to life, accepting that dying is living, that living is dying and that all this is joy now. To pray is to relativize everything that is mine, welcoming the transience of my history, my ideas, my works, that my life and my works only find meaning in salvation received, accepted, celebrated as grace. The Holy Spirit is in these alert and awake believers, leading them to the truth. Simeon goes to the temple moved by the Holy Spirit, there he receives the parents with the child, and welcomes the child in his arms. In this maternal attitude she blesses God proclaiming the "Nunc Dimittis": "Now, Lord, according to your promise, you can let your servant go in peace ...
