**Reflection:**

Jesus is seen here in a towering rage. Yet, there was nothing new about the buying and the selling that was taking place in the Temple. It had been going on for generations. His anger reminds us that anger as an emotion is not wrong in and of itself. Because practices are long-established does not mean they should continue to be tolerated. There are things we really should get angry about, such as injustice and inequality in our country and our world. How might I express righteous indignation? “Take these things out of here!” Like Jesus’, my body is a temple. St Paul asks, ‘Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God, and that you are not your own?’ What needs cleansing in me so that I can fittingly house the Spirit of God? Jesus was not satisfied with the respect the people were showing in the Temple. This was a sacred place where God in a particular way was present. All should be in touch with him there, reverencing him and talking to him. Commercial trading was unfitting in such a place. The Son of God made an effort to cleanse the area. Jesus knew that he was the real temple of God – the Lord being fully present in him. He deserved greater attention than this sacred building. He was aware too that, if he were humanly killed, he would rise from the dead. The temple of his body was indestructible. Those present did not really see through Jesus, but he knew the hearts of them all. He was aware of what was bright and dark in each. “For he himself knew what was in everyone.”
