Reflection:

The good intention is not to condemn, but God does not force us to be saved. We have been created with freedom of choice. That means we can make both bad and good choices. If I look at the past 24 hours, where have I chosen wisely and where have I not?

Eugene H. Peterson was a Presbyterian minister and theologian who, paraphrasing the New Testament, translated "sense for sense" rather than "word for word." Your paraphrase of the first line of the second paragraph above is illuminating. “This is the crisis that we have in the light of God that illuminates the world, but men and women everywhere are running into darkness. They went for the dark, because they weren't really interested in pleasing God. Every person who has the practice of doing evil, addicted to denial and illusion, hates the light of God and does not want to approach it.... But whoever works and lives in truth and reality, receives the light of God so that work is seen as God's work ”. This Gospel highlights the importance of faith and is very comforting. All of us who believe in Jesus, who died and rose for us, have eternal life. God sent his Son into the world so that he could be saved, and not to condemn him. Jesus is the key to salvation.

All the blessings we long for are contained in Christ. We are prone to error and sin. But God's mercy and goodness toward us always rescues us. Believing in Jesus is a light, a light that illuminates us and our entire environment. And yet some prefer to live in the dark, which is an indication that they are closed, perhaps due to sin. Such people do not want the luminosity of faith, which can show them their mistakes.
