Reflection:

In every death, there is life - this is the great message of Lent and Holy Week. The grain of wheat will die, and through its death it will feed us. In the death of relationships, of health, of Faith and of everything that may be very dear to us, there will always be the invitation to a deeper life. Our final death will be the call to eternal life.

Jesus, in this time of prayer, I imagine you putting a grain of wheat in my hand. You and I talk about what that might mean. When I eat bread later, it will have a deeper meaning for me. When I share in the Eucharist, I will try to be aware of what Your own life means, which is blessed, broken, shared and consumed by the life of the world.

“If the grain of wheat does not fall to the ground and die, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. ” In my life, what needs to fall to the ground and die, so that I can bear much fruit?

With Holy Week fast approaching, Jesus here speaks to us in the shadow of the valley of death. We remember that without Good Friday, there could not be Easter Sunday.
