**Reflection:**

Preparing an important dinner requires time and care. Jesus' instructions were simple: neither demanding nor lavish. The context was Passover, which commemorated the liberation of the Jews from slavery, by means of a dinner celebrated in that spirit. Unleavened bread and wine were part of the ritual. For us, Jesus becomes broken bread. The chalice of blessing is the blood of the New Covenant, which will be shed for us. Jesus uses everyday signs to present us with a profound message. His surrender is total, as is the bread when it is eaten and the wine when it is drunk: there is nothing left. As Eucharistic persons, we are to be taken, blessed, divided, and given to others, just as Jesus did. His continual Presence feeds us, and at the same time we feed those around us.

The chalice of blessing is the blood of the New Covenant, which would be shed for us. Jesus uses everyday signs to present us with a profound message. His surrender is total, as is the bread when it is eaten and the wine when it is drunk: there is nothing left. As Eucharistic persons, we are to be taken, blessed, divided, and given to others, just as Jesus did. His continual Presence feeds us, and at the same time we feed those around us.

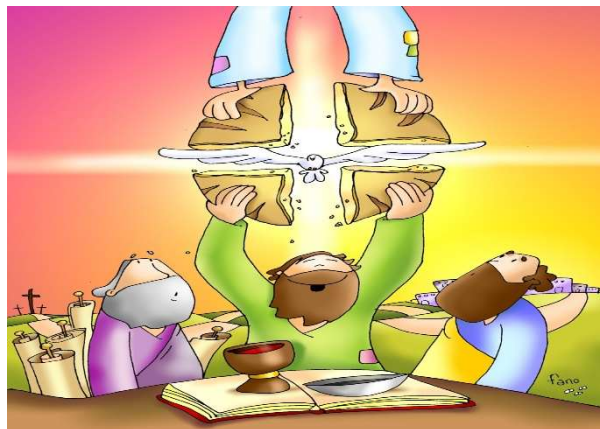
