Reflection:

The most painful wounds that we bring from the past belong more to the spirit than to the body. The one that causes us most pain from these spiritual wounds is the belief that we are insignificant. In this paragraph of the Gospel, we hear the words of Jesus to the leper, his concern to heal this wound that we carry with us from the past in your prayer today, tell Jesus how you were hurt or hurt by something that people said about you or did to you. Hear how sensitive and responsible it is when He is moved with mercy or compassion for you. Tell Him how you feel about the way He is.

The leper does not consider: "I have visited others to heal myself, and now I will deal with Jesus" - he simply knows that Jesus has the power - his only concern is: "Will He use that power on me?" Jesus looks at me too, ready to use his power for my good.
