Reflection:

The Lord invites us to believe despite not having seen. To believe in God's infinite love for us. It invites us to conversion, to return to God, to move away from the life of sin. Let us remember that this is why Jesus Christ has come, to rescue us from sin and open the doors to heaven again. And, for this, let us remember that he expects each one of us to freely seek him. Let's not let time pass. Let's go back to the Father's house. Let us follow the ways of our Lord Jesus Christ: Let us love God above all things and our neighbor. If we really love, we will be on the road to conversion, because the one who truly loves is the one who imitates God, because God is love, the Apostle John tells us, and the command of Jesus Christ is: "Love one another as I do. I have loved". For this reason, the authentic conversion of the heart is the imitation of the loving Christ, who loved us and gave himself for us.

The Church, through the catechism, reminds us that each person, you or I, must respond freely to God's invitation to believe. That very personal response of each one is faith.

It also reminds us that faith is not something more personal, because we would not have received it if there were not other people who transmitted it to us. Let us remember that it is not enough to believe in Jesus Christ for us to achieve eternal life and be saved. It is necessary that our life be transformed into a life full of works according to the commands of Jesus Christ: works full of love for God and our fellow men.

Faith does not come just like that to others. It is necessary that there are other people who take it to those who do not know it. All Christians, all members of the Church are called to transmit the faith to others, beginning with our children. No one can give what he does not know. For this reason, it is necessary that we know our faith better every day, so that we can transmit it to others, starting with those at home.
